JAMES P. BRADLEY, MD



James P. Bradley, MD graduated from Penn State University and Georgetown University School of Medicine. Dr. Bradley completed a residency in orthopedic surgery at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine and a fellowship at the Kerlan-Jobe Orthopedic clinic in Los Angeles. Dr. Bradley has been named one of the “Top 19 U.S. Sports Medicine Specialists” and top “16 Standout North American Sports Knee Surgeons” in the United States in Orthopedics This Week. He has also been included as one of the “65 Outstanding Shoulder Surgeons and Specialists” in Becker’s Orthopedic, Spine, and Pain Management Review. He has also been named to “America’s Top Doctors” nationally and “Top Sports Medicine Specialist in the Pittsburgh region. Dr. Bradley was honored by the NFL with the Jerry Hawk Rhea Award for being a dedicated and outstanding NFL Team Physician.

He is a 2025 inductee to the Western Chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame. The National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame awarded Dr. Bradley the “2024 Distinguished American Award.” The American Orthopedic Society for Sports Medicine awarded Dr. Bradley the “Revere Award” for his contribution to sports medicine education over the years. Dr. Bradley has been the head orthopedic surgeon for the Pittsburgh Steelers for over 30 years. He is the past president for the National Football League Physicians Society, Herodicus Society, and the American Orthopedic Society for Sports Medicine (AOSSM).

Board-certified by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgeons, Dr. Bradley is a fellow of the Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons and is clinical professor for the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine, and Department of Orthopedic Surgery.
